SCENARIO 1: Society

- what you did to improve your language skills
- whether you would consider working in another country in the future.

You should write approximately 180–240 characters.

SCENARIO 2: Culture

Recently you visited China. You were invited to get together with some Chinese friends. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Chinese (Traditional)**, for your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where you and your friends met **and** why they organised this
- how you got on with the new people you met
- what you thought of the food you tried
- what else you did during your stay in China
- what you thought of the places you visited
- if you would like to travel to China again.

You should write approximately 180–240 characters.
