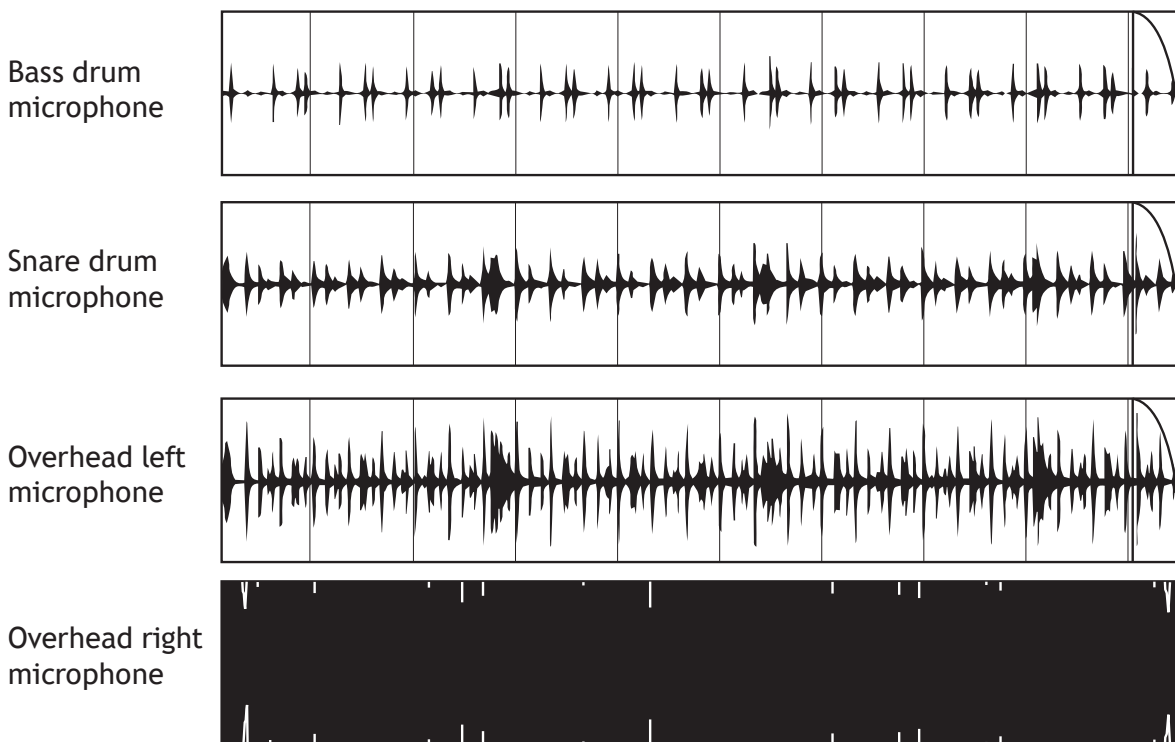

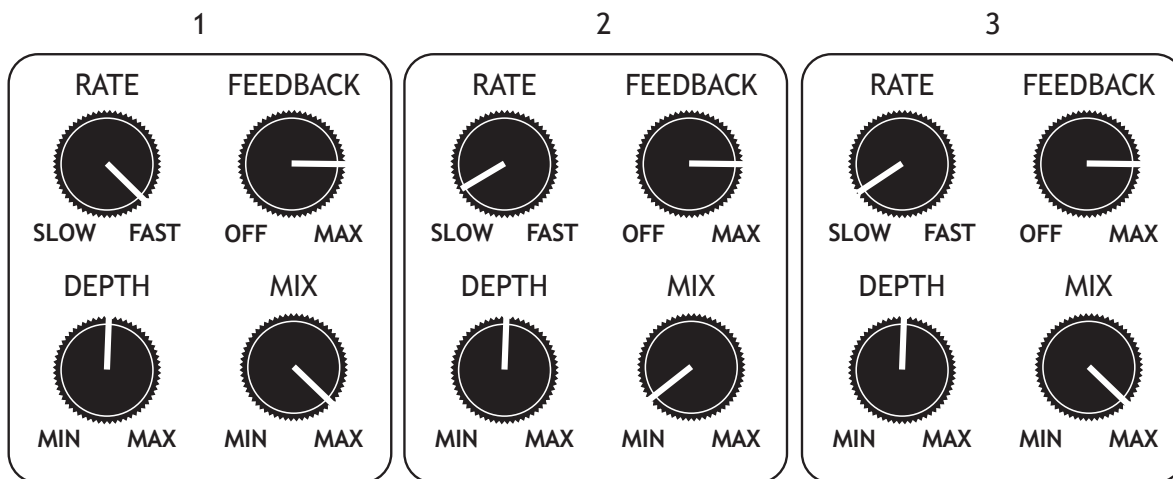

Question 5

This question is about intellectual property issues.

You will hear **two** excerpts of music.

The first excerpt ‘Metal on Metal’ by Kraftwerk in 1977.

The second excerpt ‘Nur Mir’ by Sabrina Setlur in 1997.

For nearly 20 years the German electronic music pioneers Kraftwerk fought a copyright dispute with German pop artist Sabrina Setlur. They claimed the use of a two second audio snippet from their track ‘Metal on Metal’ in the background of the song ‘Nur Mir’ violated their property right.

The original verdict by the German Federal Constitutional Court claimed there was no copyright breach as the audio used was too short and therefore covered under their ‘free use’ law. However, this judgment was appealed to the European Court of Justice who overturned the ruling in favour of Kraftwerk. The judge claimed for audio to be used in this way, the composer must modify the audio so that it is ‘unrecognisable’ to the ear, which in this case, it was not.
